he NNCC, like other organizations, faced many challenges in 2020. The changing work environment required adaptions to continue our mission to promote patient safety and to improve the quality of

One of our focus areas this past year has been to promote and increase awareness of our newest certification credentials, the Certified Nephrology Nurse Practitioner (CNN-NP) and the Certified Clinical Hemodialysis Technician-Advanced (CCHT-A). Through these projects, the NNCC has increased the number of scholarships award for advancing the education of our certificants.

(N = 5,571)





in 2020




Current Certificants: January to December 2020

Note: Figures 3 - 8 identify the total number of current certificates by credential, by state.




